
TRAFALGAR RESTAURANT

HOW TO FIND US

BY RAIL

The nearest railway station is approximately 1 mile from the racecourse and is connected to the Norwich mainline service.

BY ROAD

The racecourse is situated to the north of Great Yarmouth towards Caister. From the North and Midlands the racecourse can be reached by the A47. The main southern approach roads are the A11 (joining the A47 South of Norwich) and the A12 via Colchester, Ipswich and Lowestoft.

BY BUS

The racecourse is serviced by two bus stops both within two hundred yards of the entrance. Caister Road Bus Stops – No 1, 1A & 1B services between Lowestoft and Martham, via Hopton. No 3 seasonal service from Seashore Holiday Centre to Hemsby Beach. Jellicoe Road Bus Stops - No 4 service from Seafront Pleasure Beach to Caister. No 8 & 8A services between Gorleston and Caister. All services stop at the Great Yarmouth Town Centre, Market Gates Shopping Centre. Times can be found on www. firstgroup.com and select Bus/Eastern Counties.

ADMISSION TICKETS

Your hospitality admission tickets will be sent to you approximately 14 days prior to your event. Your ticket is required for entry into the racecourse and your hospitality facility. Please ensure you and your guests display your ticket at all times during the race meeting.
